- I. Program name: Credit Program of Virtual Techniques in Applications
- II. Program coordinator: Department of Communication Arts
- III. Coordinating and review departments: Department of Communication Arts and Department of Digital Content Application And Management
- IV. Program objectives:

This program is a cross-disciplinary program that aims to cultivate outstanding professionals with the capabilities of using the virtual techniques in applications. Through an integrated operational performance of the virtual techniques , the program is additionally designed to enhance students' understanding of the operational contents of the virtual techniques and cultivate more outstanding people to dedicate to business jobs.
- V. Qualifications for application: Senior students of the four-year college program. (Students of Department of Communication Arts and Department of Digital Content Application And Management are given priority.)
- VI. Application and evaluation procedures:

Before the deadline announced by the Registration Section, applicants should complete the application form for the program to be signed by the chairperson of their department. They should then submit the application form to the Department of Communication Arts. Upon evaluation and approval, the list of students who can join the program will be announced on the university website by the Registration Section.
- VII. Credits: Minimum 20 credits.
- VIII.Regulations for the issue of program certificate:
 - (I) Review of qualifications: The department in charge of the program should complete the qualification review before students graduate.
 - (II) Issue of certificates: According to the results of qualification review provided by the department in charge of the program, the Registration Section should ask for the approval from the Dean of Academic Affairs. Upon approval, the University will issue the certificate for the “Digital Communication” credit program.
