1. Program name: Micro Program in Spanish
2. Program planification: Department of Spanish
3. Program Coordination: Department of Spanish
4. Objectives: This program aims to encourage students to learn Spanish and be acquainted with Hispanic culture and civilization. Most of the countries that hold diplomatic relationship with Taiwan locate in Latin America. Thus, to introduce basic knowledge of Spanish language and Hispanic culture to our students, the department offers a twelve-credit micro program in Spanish.
5. Qualifications for application: Sophomores or above in the four-year university program, juniors and seniors in the two-year college program are eligible for application. Applicants must submit the application before the end of the first semester of their senior year (excluding students with delayed graduation). Spanish majors and students who minor or double major in Spanish are not eligible for application.
6. Application requirements:
 - (1) The GPA of all academic years and conduct should be above 75 (including 75).
 - (2) An Interview will be conducted when it is necessary.
7. Credits: It is required that each student completes at least 12 credits.
8. Application procedure: As announced by the Office of Academic Affairs on their website.
9. Evaluation procedure:
 - (1) Evaluation of qualification: The Department of Spanish verifies if the student has completed the requirements before graduation.
 - (2) Certification: Based on the results of evaluation, the Registration Section in the Office of Academic Affairs will inquire the approval from the Dean of Academic Affairs. Upon approval, the university will issue a certificate of completion in “ Micro Program in Spanish”.
