- I. Program name: “Micro Program in Southeast Asian Languages”
- II. Program planning department: Department of Southeast Asian Studies
- III. Coordinating department: Department of Southeast Asian Studies
- IV. Program objectives:  
On the basis of the language advantage, students can develop their second and third foreign language skills.
- V. Qualifications for application: junior students of the four-year college program and junior students of the two-year college program
- VI. Credits: minimum 11 credits
- VII. Application procedures: online application according to the announcement of the office of the academic affairs
- VIII. Evaluation procedures:
  - (II) Review of qualifications: The department in charge of the program should complete the qualification review before students graduate.
  - (III) Issue of certificates: According to the results of qualification review provided by the department in charge of the program, the Registration Section should ask for the approval from the Dean of Academic Affairs. Upon approval, the University will issue the certificate for the “International Meeting, Exhibition, Convention and Creative Marketing” credit program.
