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1. Program Name: Micro Program in Intergrating Artificial Intelligence and Humanities in Cross-Domain
2. Organized by: College of New Media and Management
3. Responsible Unit: College of New Media and Management
4. Purpose:  
This Program is designed by non-ICT (information and communications technology) teachers and teachers specialized in digital technologies based on the application needs of digital technologies, non-ICT students' specialties, and consistent curriculum planning in order to focus on incorporating ICT into training for humanities and language specialties. Students are expected to demonstrate interdisciplinary communication skills and problem-solving skills for tackling issues in their specialties with digital technologies after completing this Program. This Program aims to encourage non-ICT students to take a series of courses and participate in corresponding activities to develop core competencies for solving problems of their own specialties with digital technologies, as well as to cooperate with professionals in IT or different fields to utilize digital technologies to address industrial problems in the real world.
5. Eligibility: Second-year students or above studying in 4-year programs and first-year students or above studying in 2-year programs are qualified to apply for this Program by the end of the fall semester in the final year of their studies (excluding the maximum extension period of study).
6. Credit Requirements: 8 credits shall be earned in completing this Program.
7. Application Procedure: Fill out the application online within the period specified by the Office of Academic Affairs.
8. Review Procedure:
  - (1) Eligibility Review: The responsible unit verifies the completion of program requirements prior to graduation.
  - (2) Certificate Issuance: Wenzao will grant a certificate of Micro Degree Program in Interdisciplinary Design of Artificial Intelligence and Humanities after the Registration Section obtains the approval and signature of the Dean of Academic Affairs based on the result of an eligibility review.
